

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Gregory Memorial Presbyterian Church Session was held on Tuesday, August 21, 2012 and the following actions were approved:

- Approved an Eagle Scout project to have a spaghetti dinner at the church on October 27, 2012.
- Approved use of the Sanctuary and Fellowship Hall to be used by the Boy Scouts for an Eagle Scout ceremony on September 22, 2012.

- Approved request from Pre-School board for one family to have reduced tuition for 2012-2013.

- Approved a Temporary Supply Covenant between Gregory Memorial Presbyterian Church and Rev. Beverly Bullock to remain in effect until January 3, 2013 unless a permanent installed pastor is called before that date.


