

Dear Gregory Memorial, Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



"For the Lord your God is God of gods and Lord of lords, the great God, mighty and awesome, who is not partial and takes no bribe, who executes justice for the orphan and the widow, and who loves the strangers, providing them with food and clothing. You shall also love the stranger, for you were strangers in the land of Egypt." ~Deuteronomy 10:17-19

Just about anyone could tell you that transitions are tough. Starting or ending a job, moving from one grade-level to another, getting used to a new routine...these are all difficult and trying times in life. One often experiences feelings of disorientation or loneliness, changes in appetite, and even mood swings which affect those who are closest to the individual. And the larger the transition, the greater the effect upon the individual and those in the area. Relocation from one area to another is one of the greatest stressors on an individual, for precisely these reasons.

In all my work with those in transition (and experiencing it myself), one of the greatest gifts to help alleviate the stress of transition is to be made to feel welcome, and on the other side of that coin, to make a new person feel welcome.

I can tell you with no uncertainty, I (and Megan) have certainly been made to feel welcomed in our new community and church! Thank you for this gift, which is the basis of all the other gifts we have already received from y'all! With all that we have received, and especially the kind words and the ways many of you have reached out to check-in on us, we know that you care, and that has made the beginnings of this transition much easier to bear. Thank you!

Many have commented that this is 'Southern culture' at its best. This may very well be true, but I'd like us to consider framing it in a much deeper – and needed in this world – culture, that of Christian discipleship. The

tenets of Christianity, the Great Ends of the Church (PCUSA), the Great Commandment...these all have in common an embracing, welcoming love of the stranger. Even more so, it is a love that enables to see *the other* as someone who is, in actuality, part of *the us*. There is no longer an *us/them*; there is only *we*! When we reach out in the love of Christ we have received, everyone is welcomed into our fellowship. You of Gregory Memorial have shown yourselves very capable of this in the way you have welcomed Megan and me; my challenge to you will be to continue this practice into the entire community of Prince George!

We are called to love God, to make Christ known, to proclaim the Good News of salvation, and in all of this, to reach out to others in Christian love, not as a stranger to be converted, but as a brother or sister to greeted after a long absence (the Parable of the Prodigal Son comes to mind...).

I look forward, in the months to come, to getting to know all of you, to breaking down the lack of relationship that creates boundaries. This is my first and most immediate priority. Then, I look forward to, with all of you, reaching out to the community at large, erasing all lines of "stranger" in this community, for the greater glory of God. It's going to be a great adventure!
