How could they not be excited to hear these prophetic promises?

It was their call, as it is for us today, to look for the ways in which God is creating their (our) future, and then join God in that work. It requires us to look with critical eyes for what God is doing, and to trust that what God is doing and where God is leading, is truly in our best interest as Christ's church in this world.

I have plans, yes, and ideas – new member classes, refresher member classes, baptism and confirmation groups, fellowship gatherings, mission endeavors, and more! Furthermore, I am taking my ideas and holding them faithfully against what I hear from all of you – desires and hopes and vision. But the foundation of all of this is and will always remain: What is God doing, and how do these ideas/plans tie in with that?

I believe that God has vision and plans for the Church, Gregory Memorial included. I believe that the Spirit is not far off, but is constantly at work in the world and in our lives, our community. I believe that the love of Christ, known in his teachings and examples, holds deep meaning still for us today. I intend to seek out the ways in which we are a part of this, not simply for our own fortune, but for the greater proclamation of God's Kingdom.

I very much look forward to doing this all with you.
