GATHERING Prophecv Jeremiah 33: 14-16 Pa. 645 "O Come, O Come Emmanuel" \*HYMN #88, Verses 1, 2 \*LIGHTING OF ADVENT CANDLES (Responsive) One: The true light, which enlightens everyone, was coming into the world. We light these candles as a sign of the coming light of Christ. In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. Come, let us walk in the light of the Lord! All: (The First Advent Candle is lit) He was in the beginning with God. All things came into One: being through him and without him not one thing came into being. All: Come, let us walk in the light of the Lord! (The Second Advent Candle is lit) What has come into being in him was life, and the life was One: the light of all people. Come, let us walk in the light of the Lord! All: (The Third Advent Candle is lit) The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not One: overcome it. All: Come, let us walk in the light of the Lord! (The Fourth Advent Candle is lit) And the Word became flesh and lived among us, and we One: have seen his glory, the glory as of a father's only son, full of grace and truth. All: The Light still shines! Glory! Glory! The Light of the Ages shines on! Come, let us walk in the light of the Lord! (The Christ Candle is lit, as we continue to sing)
