

Larry Johnson's dad, Clarence Johnson, passed away in 1994. Clarence liked to call the following ideas his "Laws of Nature." Clarence believed in these tenets of human behavior he called "Laws" and embraced them in his everyday living. They are still worthwhile for us today:

A man is born beside the road to death. To die is not so bad; it is inevitable. What matters is the journey, and what one does along the way. And it's not whether he succeeds or fails, but only that he has lived proudly, with honor and respect, then he can die proudly.

Your life, whether it be twenty years or ninety, is but the twinkling of an eye, between two eternities. You have no time to waste, and you will not have a second chance.

We do not do the right thing because we have integrity. But rather, we have integrity because we do the right thing.

Every man takes care that his neighbor shall not cheat him. But when a man really becomes a man, he will take care that he not cheat his neighbor.

You can change your entire world in thirty days, if you will treat every person you meet as the most important person on earth.

The brotherhood of man is one. Whatever you do *to* or *for* another person, you do *to* or *for* yourself.

One tragedy of our times is the disappearance of the family discussion. Next time you sit down to dinner, you might mention some of those oldfashioned words like our grandparents used to discuss: words like right and wrong, justice, honor, courage, ideals and conscience.

UPDATED WORSHIP GUIDELINES

GREETINGS SAINTS AND FRIENDS OF GREGORY MEMORIAL!

Your Session has been diligent in faithfully assessing how we continue to worship and move forward, and now especially, in light of the updated guidelines and proclamations from both CDC and local and federal leaders. Please note the following:

IF YOU ARE FULLY VACCINATED,

- We encourage those singing to wear masks when singing hymns; however, you no longer need to wear a mask when entering/exiting, or moving about the Sanctuary. Of course, if it is your personal comfort level to do so, then please be happy in doing so.
- We no longer physically block off every other pew. We encourage you to sit where you are comfortable sitting, and with whom, but please be respectful of others as we make this transition --- there may be some who are still more comfortable sitting with a bit of distance, and that's ok.
